

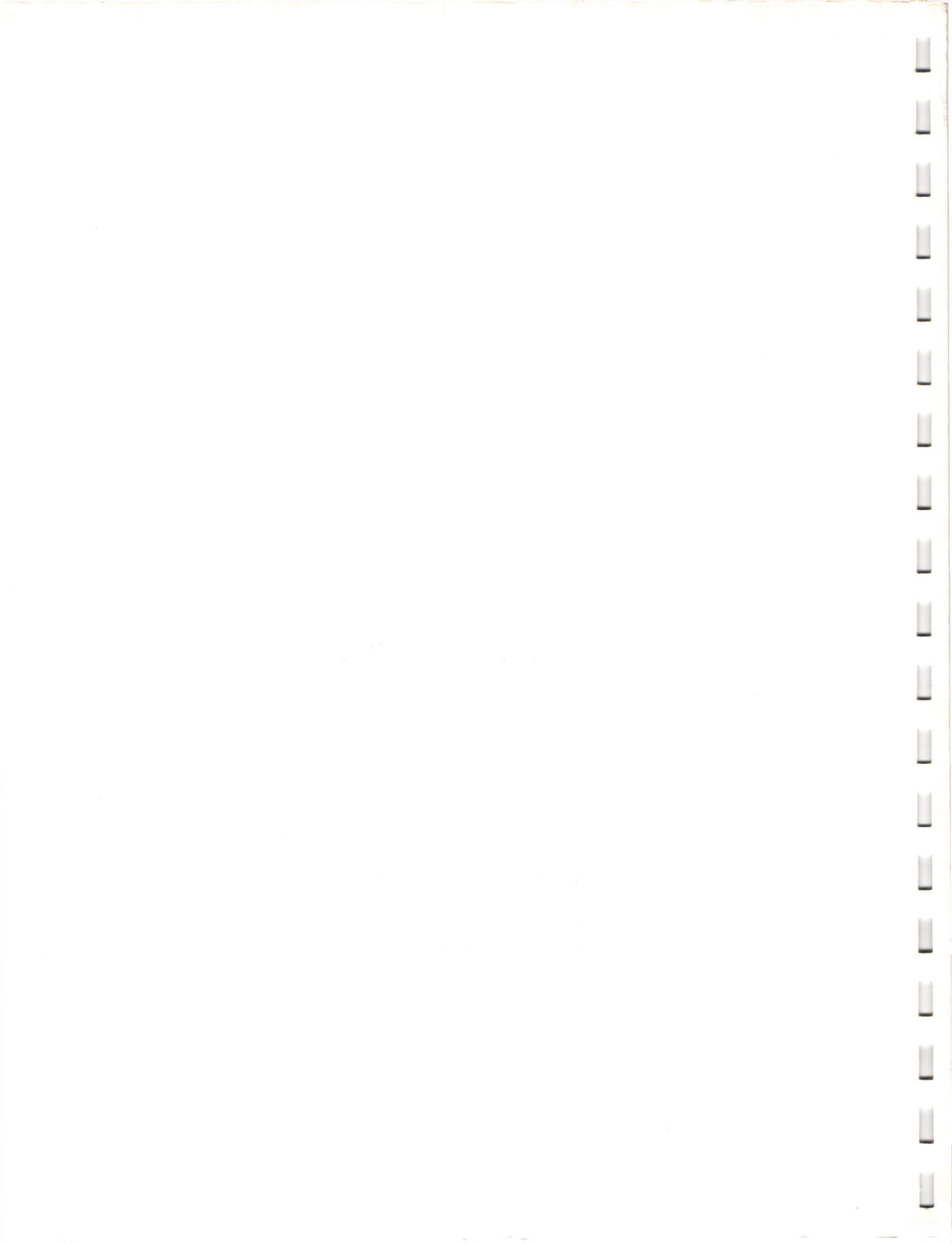

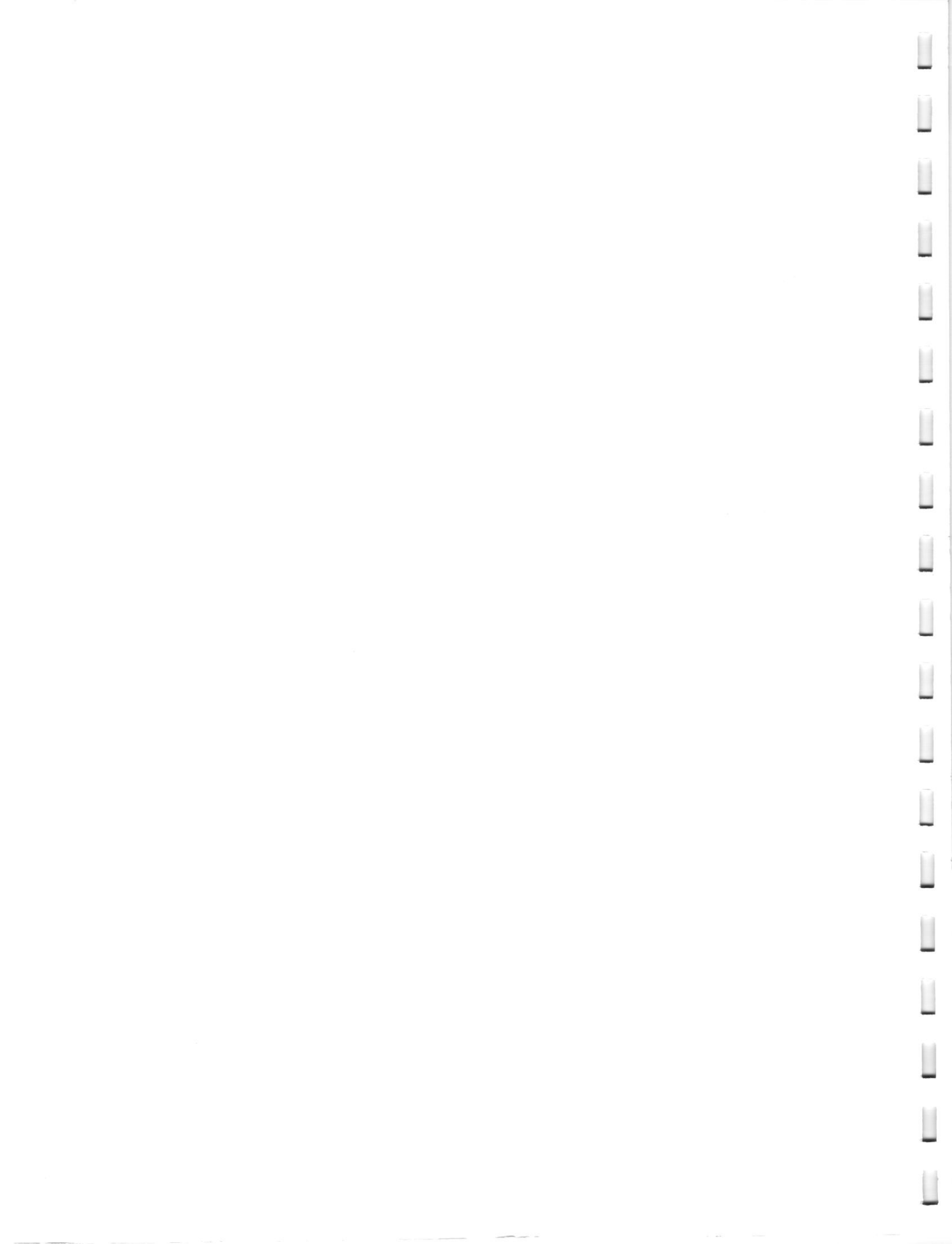
## INTRODUCTION

The Office of Institutional Research together with a Users Advisory Committee presents the fourth publication of the Oklahoma State University Student Profile. Our objective in producing this document is to provide information on previous and present Oklahoma State University student enrollment and to depict trend data in a manner which is useful in planning for the challenge which lies ahead. This report is intended as an internal reference to help the University community better understand the University's most important resource--its students.

We encourage users of this publication to direct their comments, questions and suggestions about its contents to the Office of Institutional Research.



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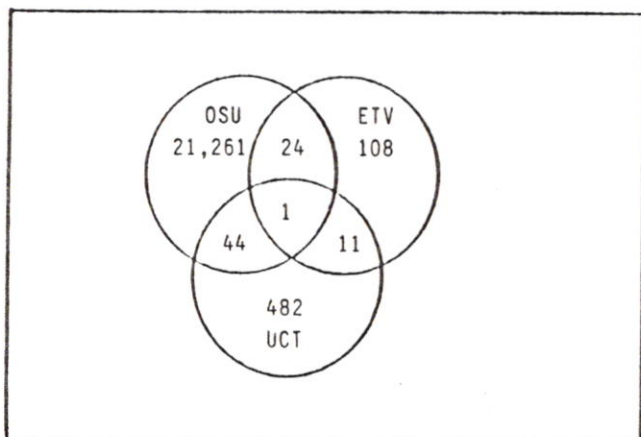

LOCATION OF TOTAL OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY STUDENT ENROLLMENT



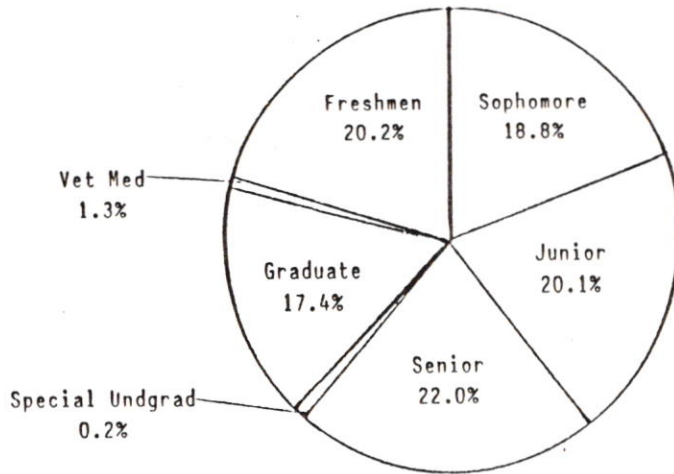

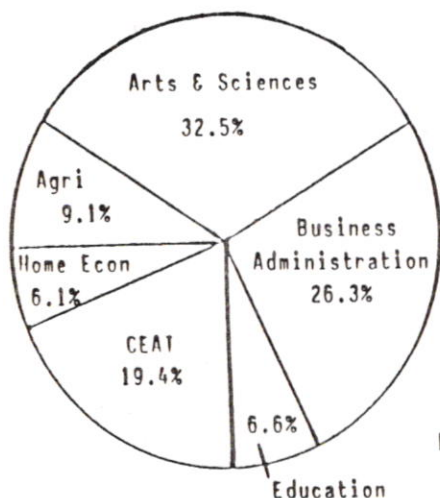

# DISTRIBUTION OF OSU MAJORS BY COLLEGE FALL SEMESTER 1984

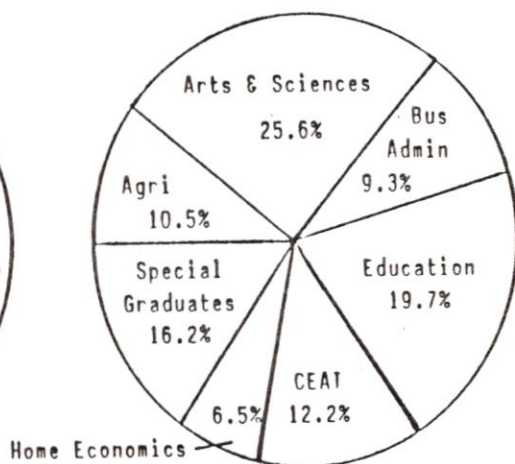

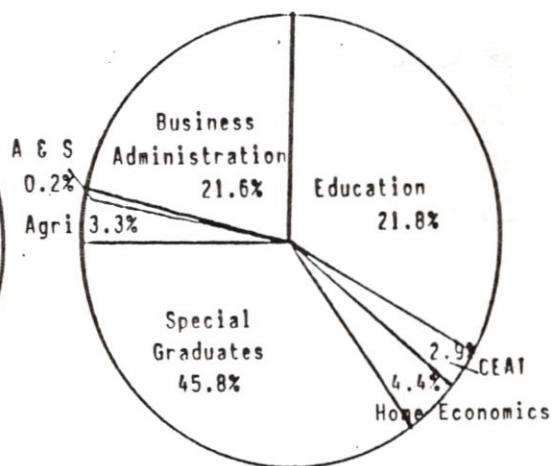

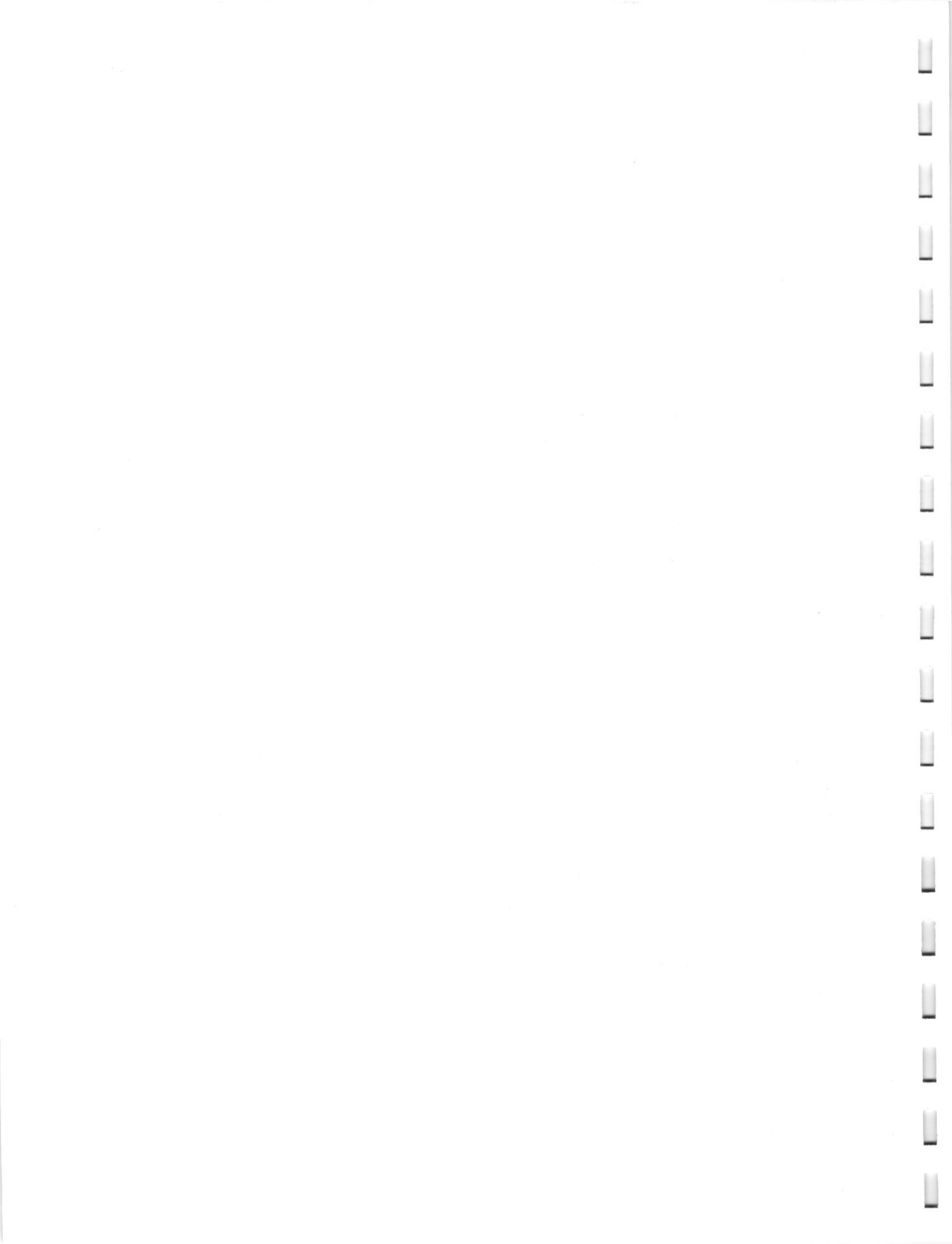

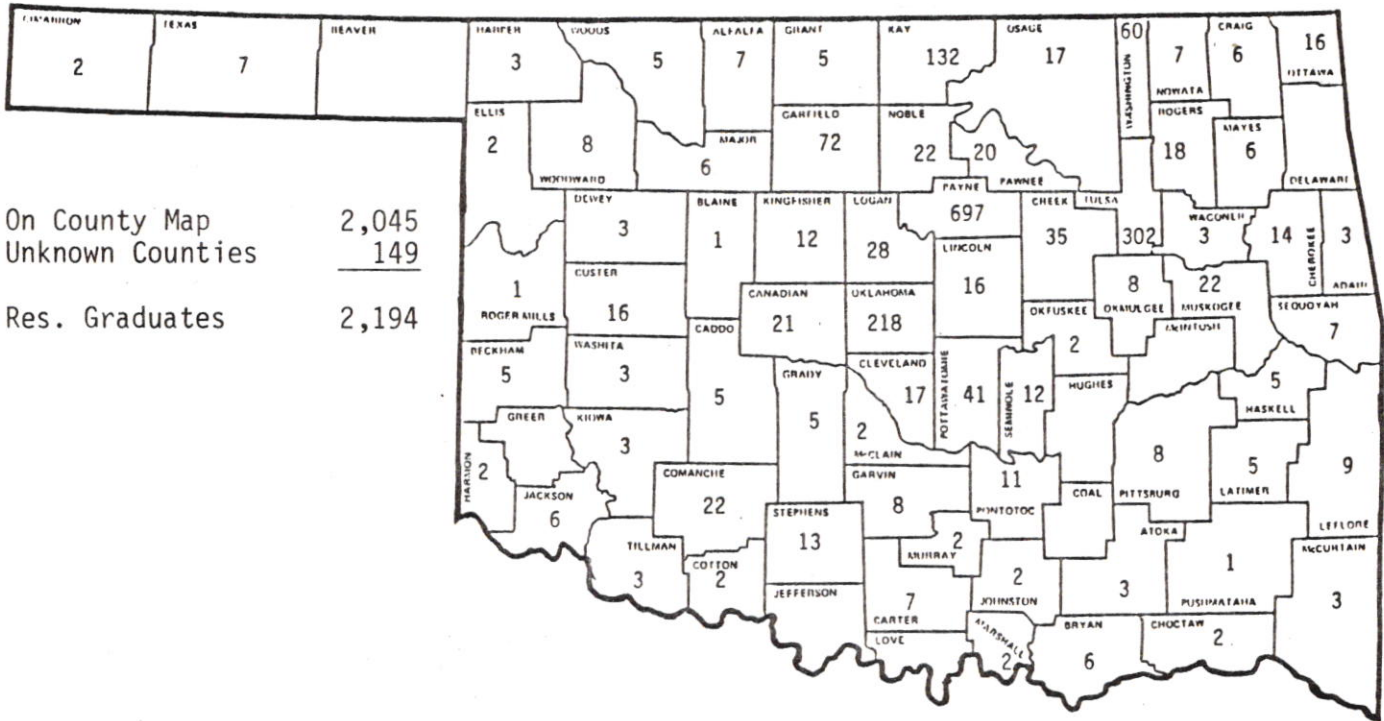

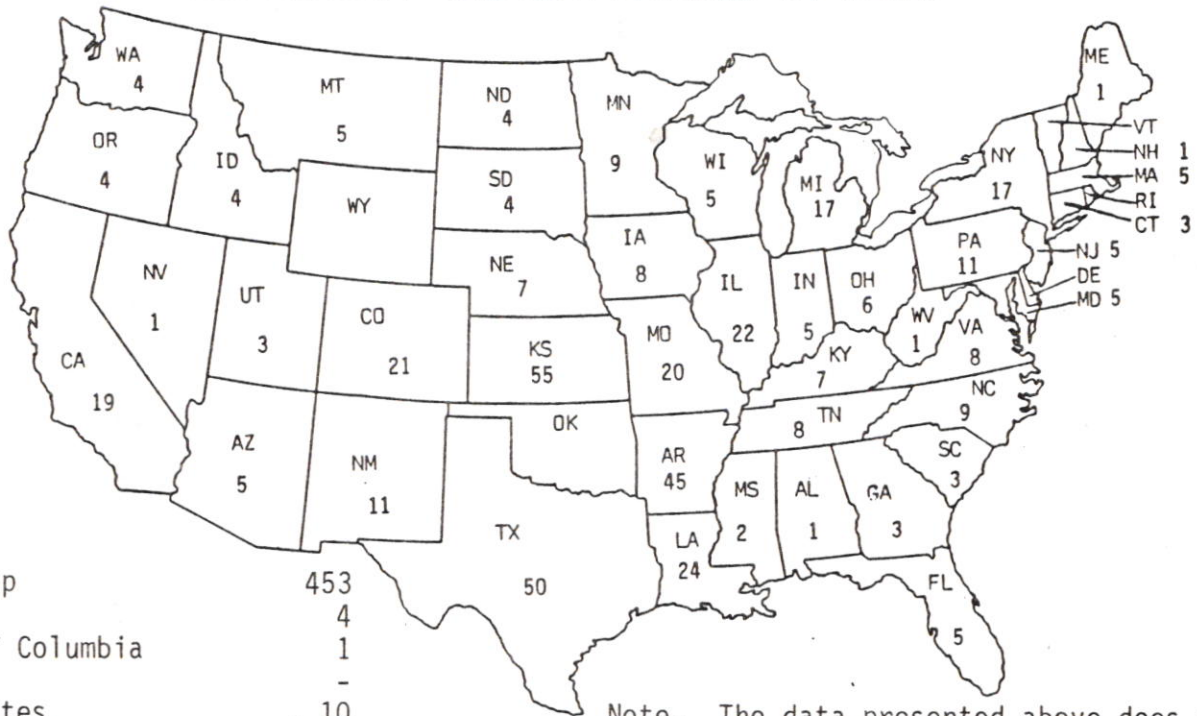


SOURCE OF GRADUATE STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS

RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY

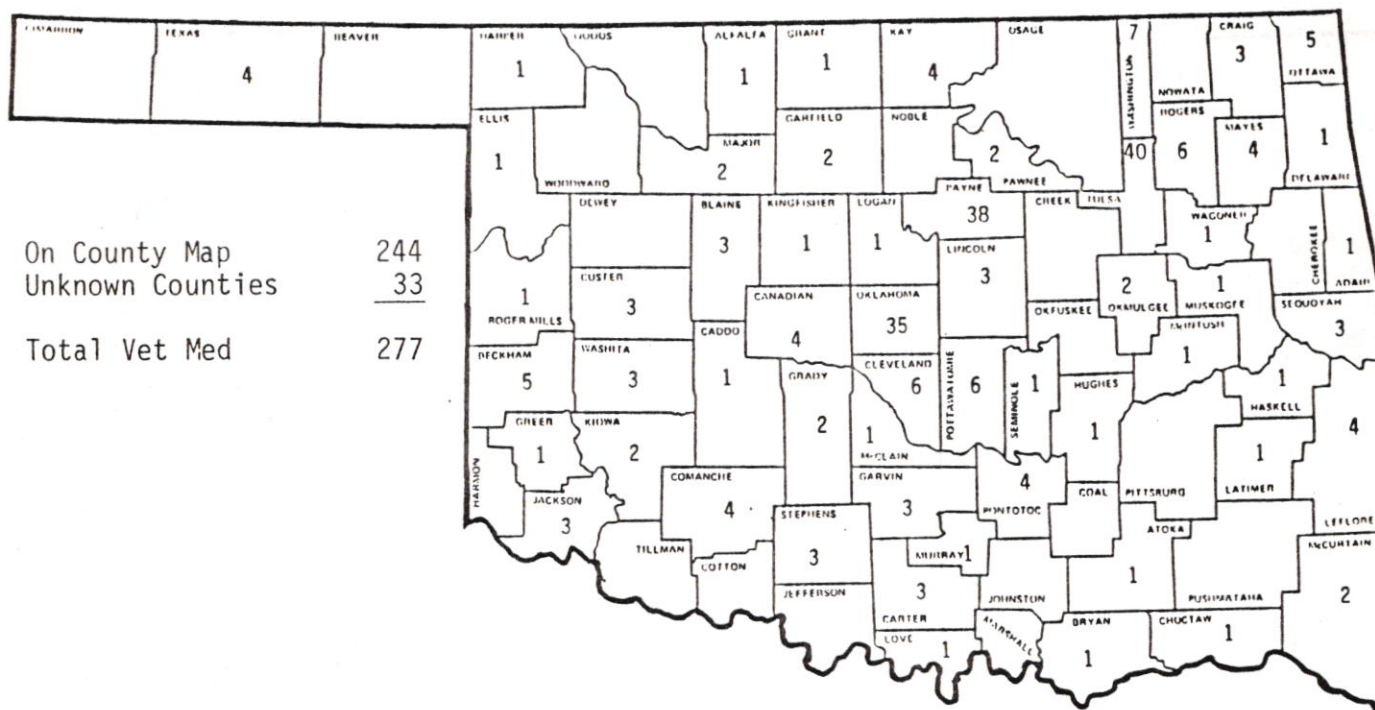


NON-RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE

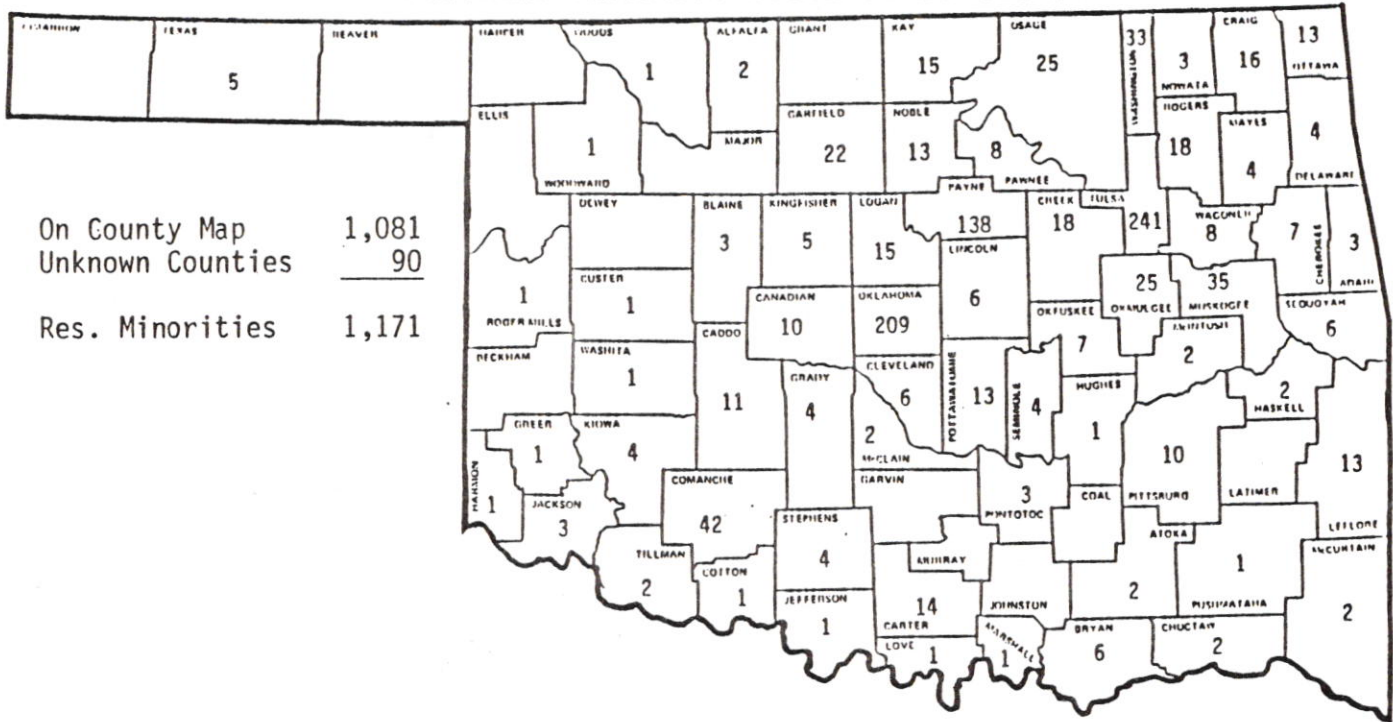

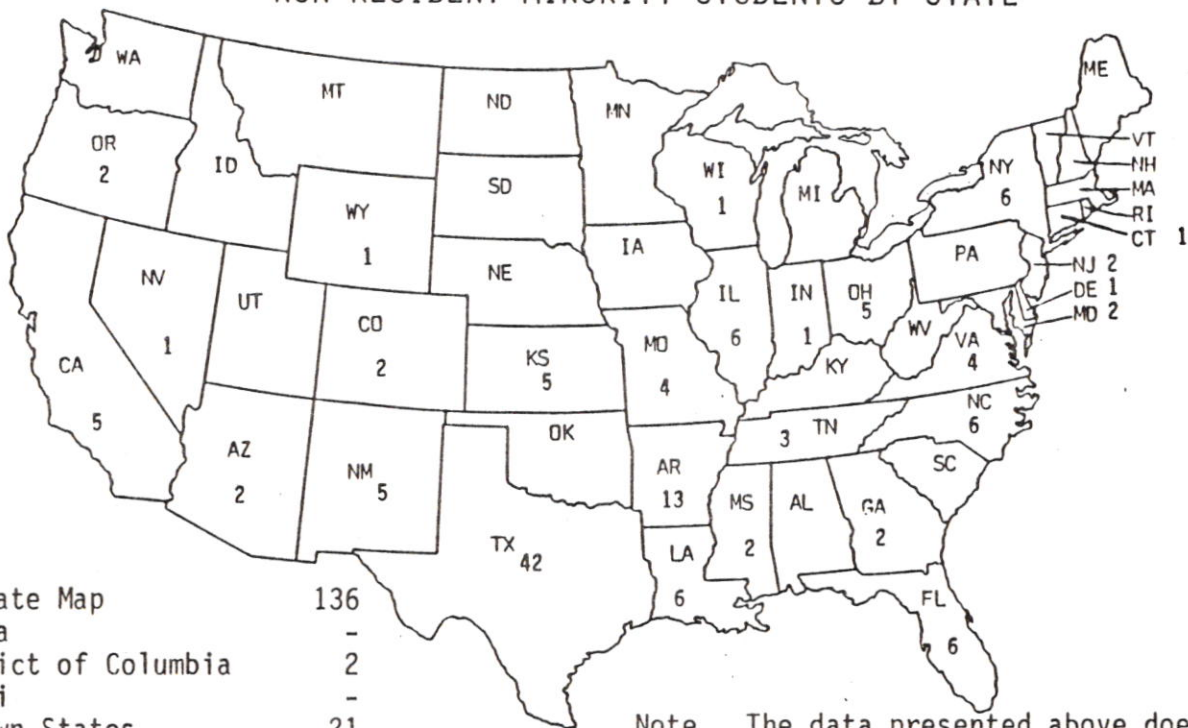


SOURCE OF MINORITY STUDENTS BY RESIDENT STATUS

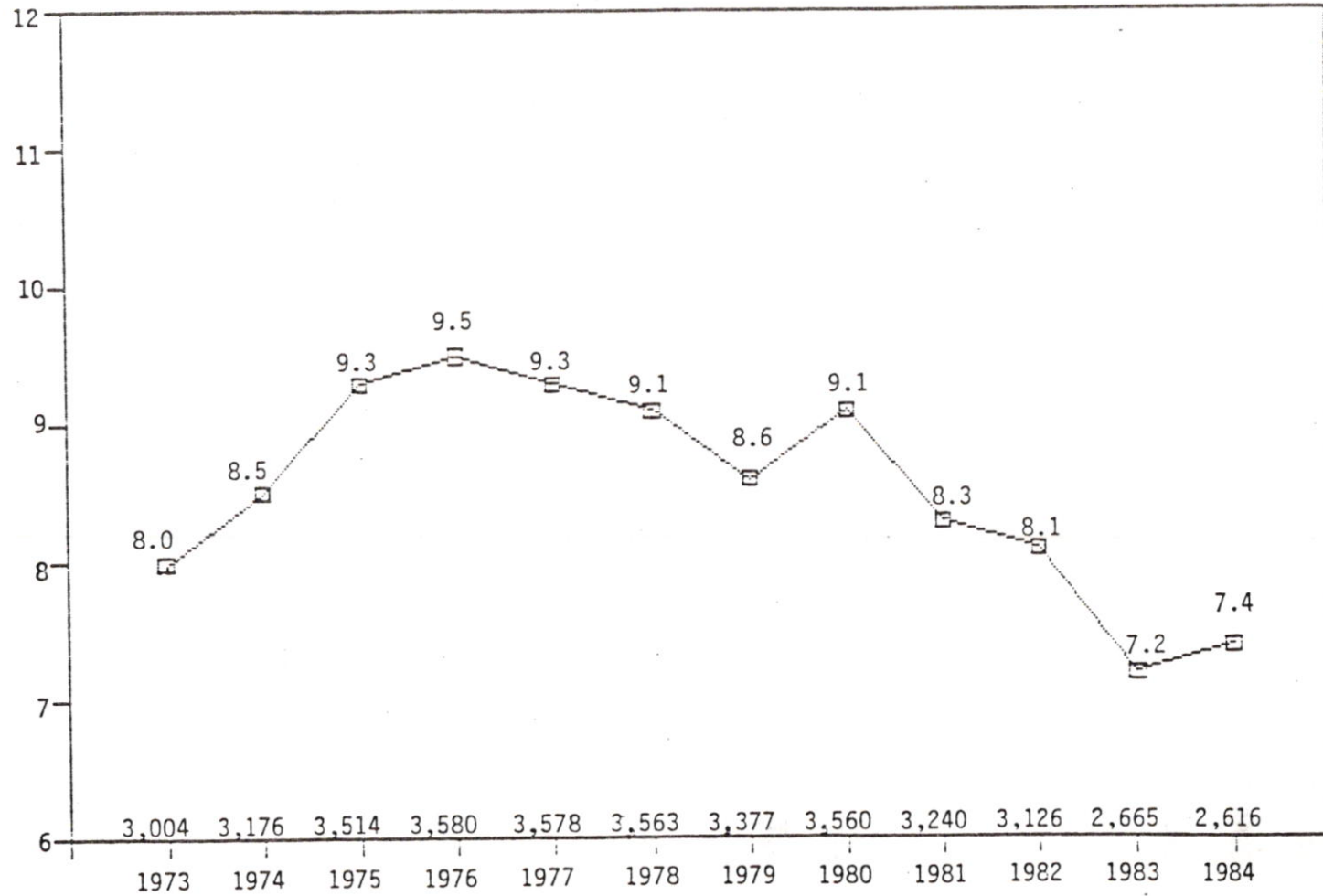

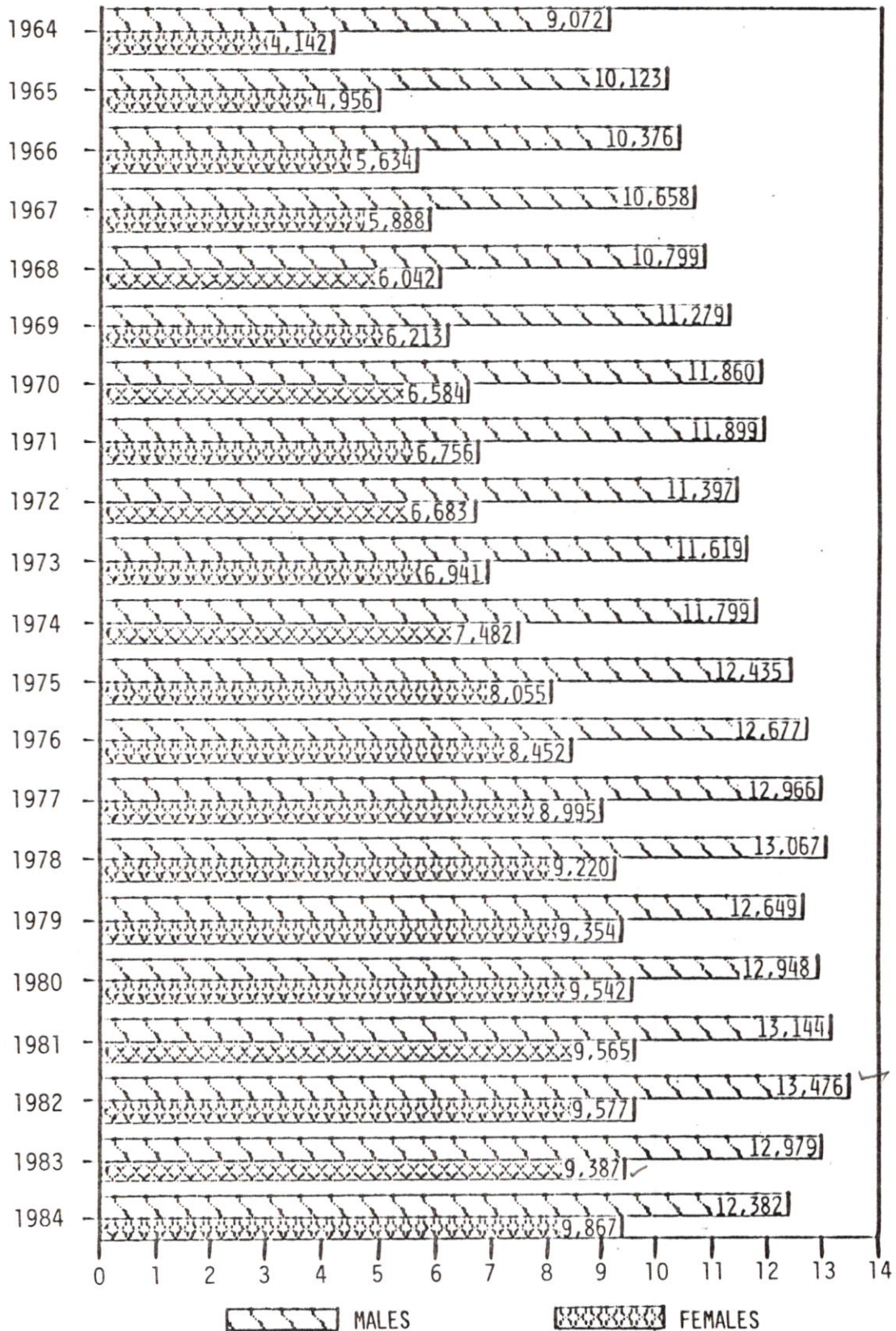

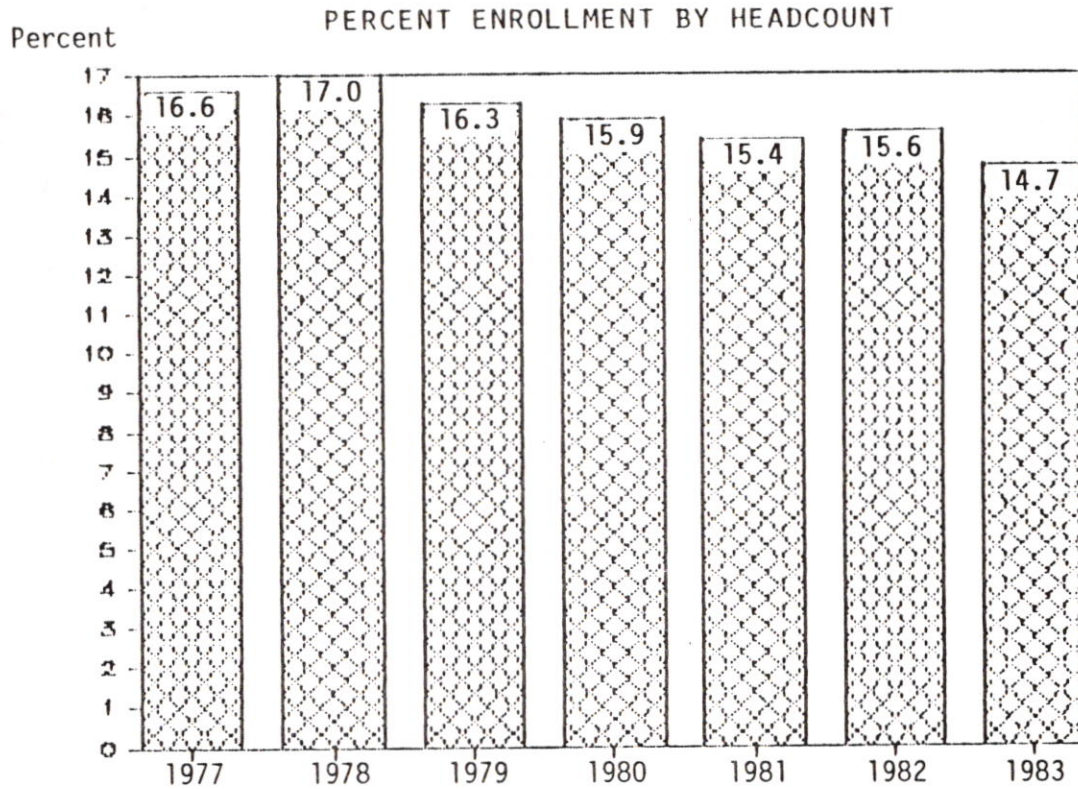

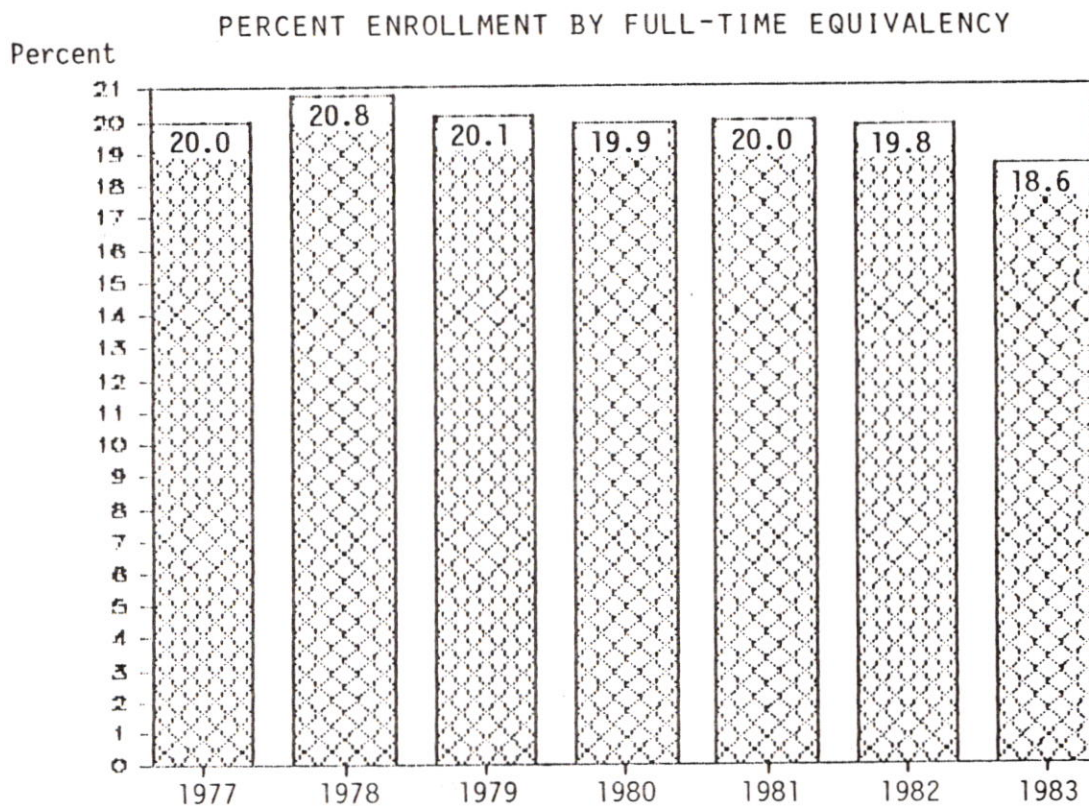

FALL SEMESTERS 1977 THROUGH 1983



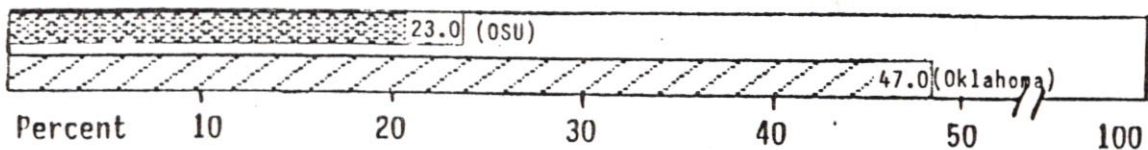
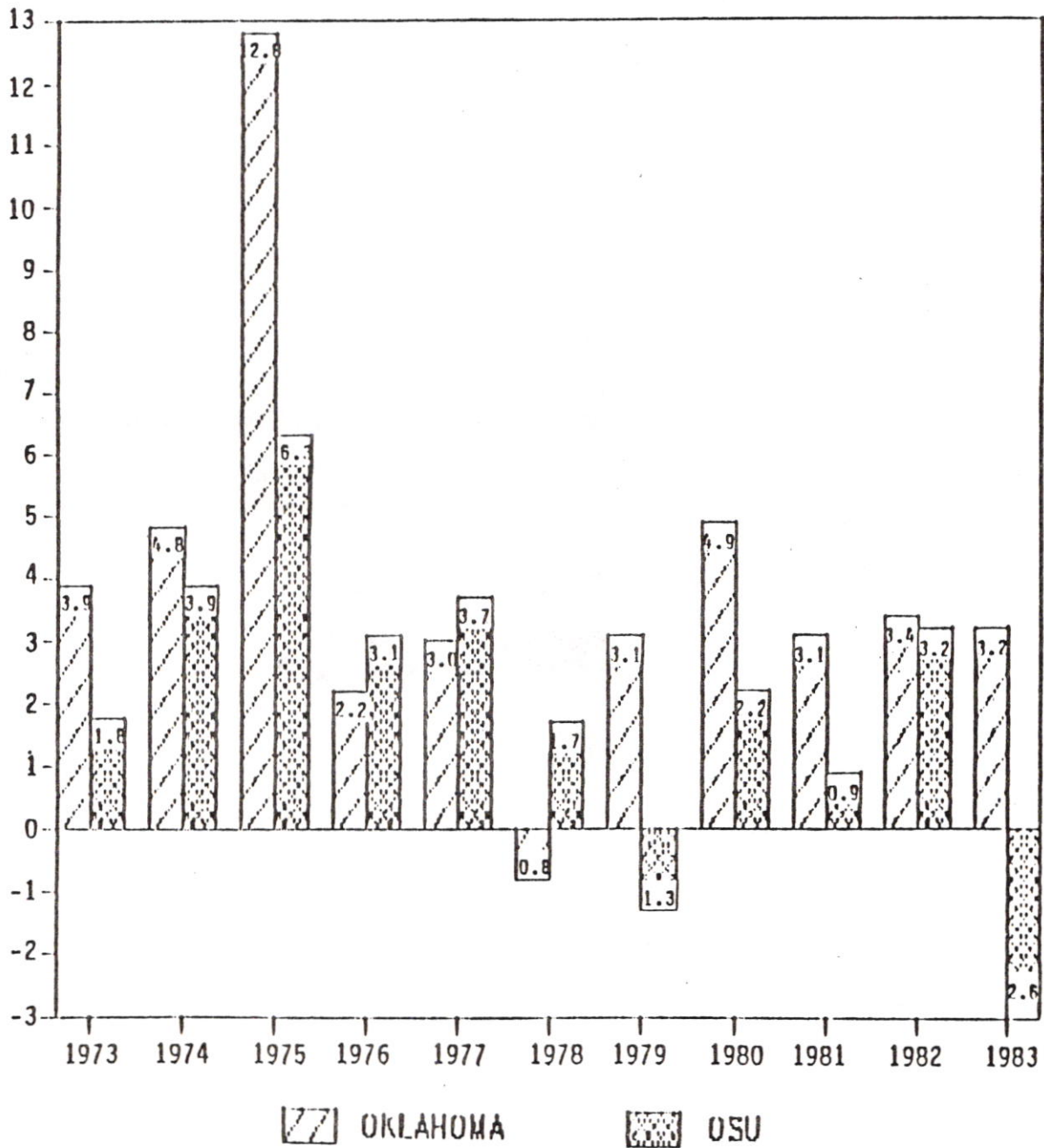

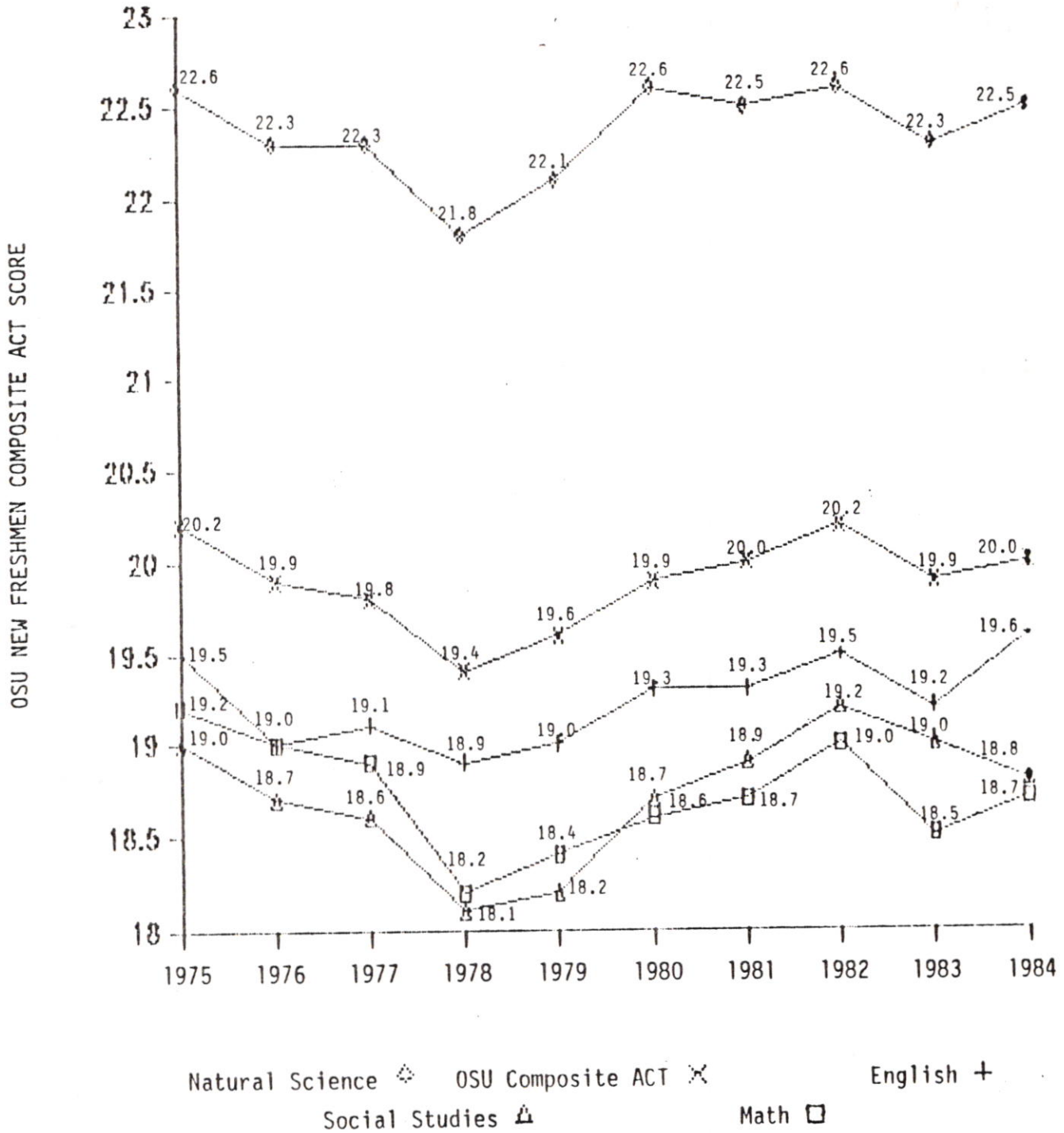

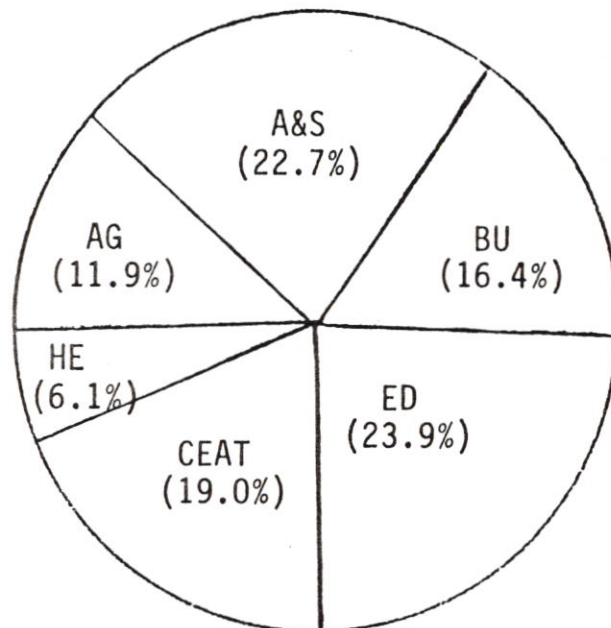

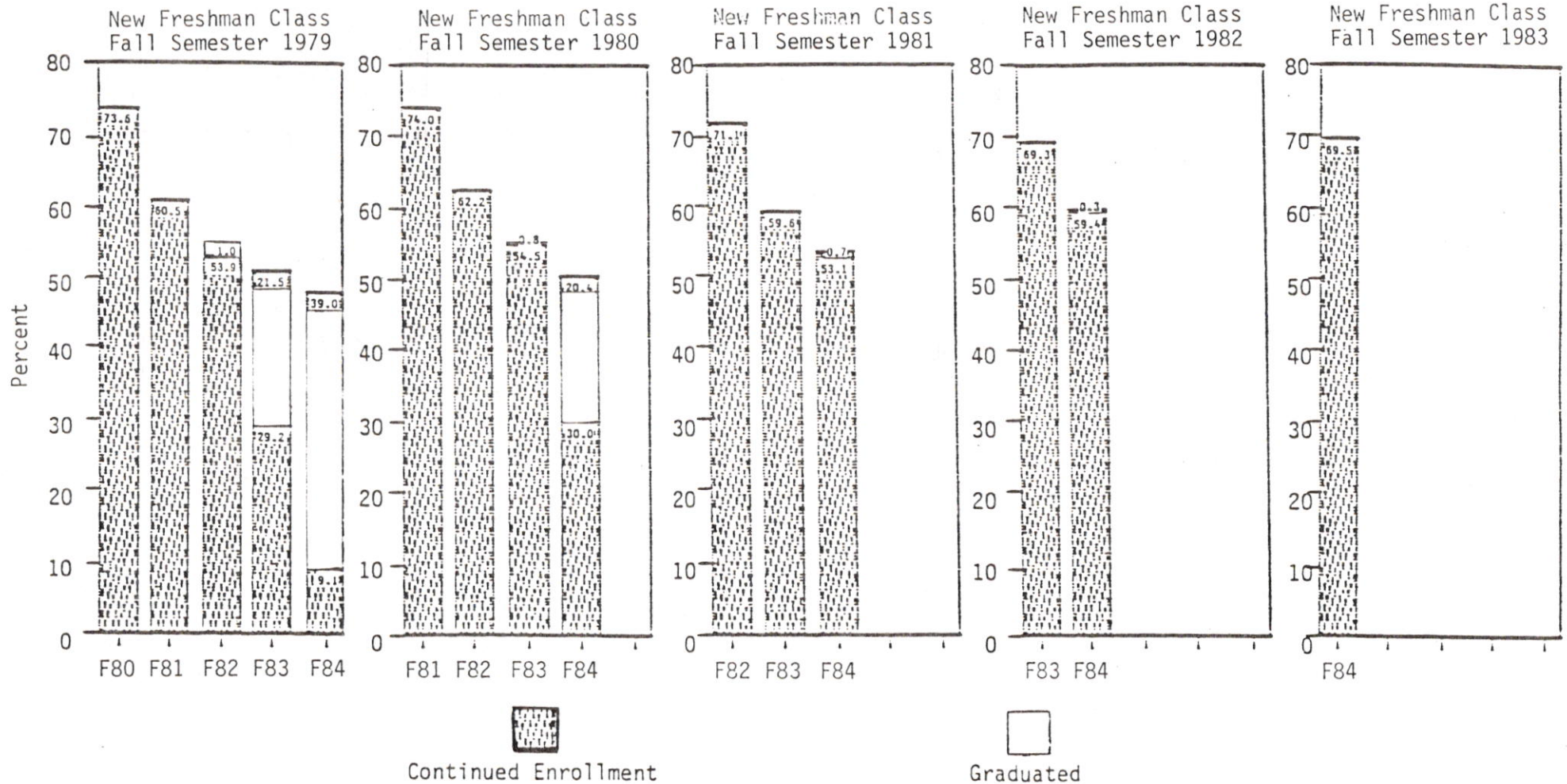

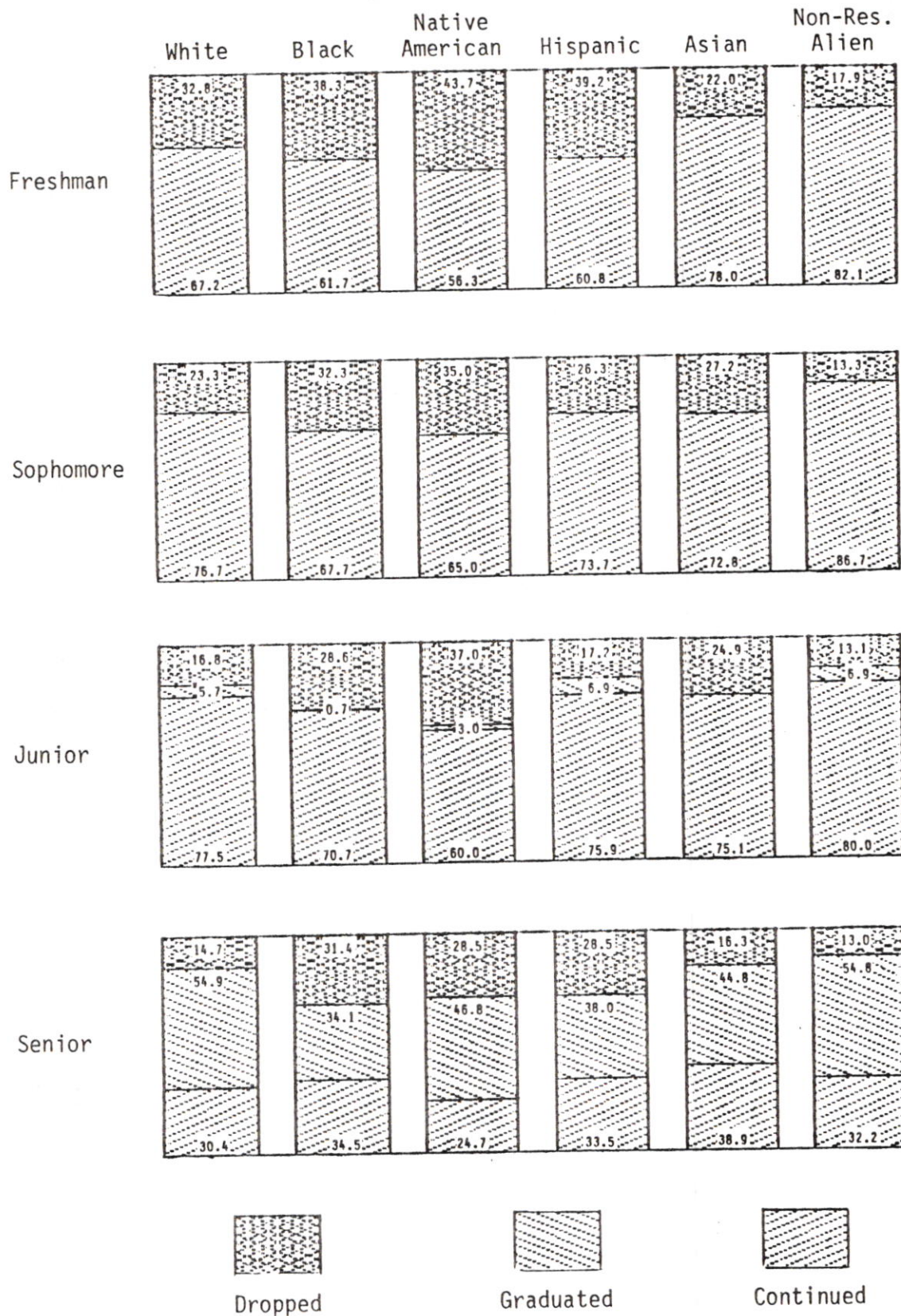

For example, of the total (100%) black students enrolled at OSU as seniors in the Fall Semester 1983, 31.4% were not enrolled at OSU in the Fall Semester 1984 nor had they graduated from OSU. These students are shown as "% Non-Returning." 34.1% of the black students enrolled in the Fall Semester 1983 had gone on to graduate prior to the Fall Semester 1984.

Return rate is computed by comparing the previous fall semester class to the current fall semester class by matching on student identification number. If a student's identification number matches, he/she is a continuing student. An example is: Of the 5,258 freshmen for Fall 1979, 3,587 returned the following fall semester giving a return rate of 68.2.

## OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

The new freshman class each Fall Semester usually follows the residency distribution pattern of the total undergraduate student body. This also proved to be true for the Fall Semester of 1984. Since 88.7% of the new freshman class are resident students, the public high schools of Oklahoma are Oklahoma State University's major source of students. Therefore, our enrollment projections must have the projection of Oklahoma public high school graduates as its basis.

The Oklahoma State Department of Public Education in past years has published a report illustrating the flow of students in public school systems of Oklahoma. This document was the source used as a basis for projecting Oklahoma public high school graduates in order to project the new freshman class at Oklahoma State University. This year the Oklahoma Statistical Data Center did not publish a similar report. They were willing to share data of a similar nature, but upon reviewing the data, it does not appear to be compatible with previous years' data. The individual who did the work in the past is no longer employed with the State, and thus is not available for consultation of the validity of this year's data. Since the projected number of high school graduates was missed by less than one percent in last year's projections, and also due to lack of comparable data, the high school graduate enrollment projections will not be revised this year.

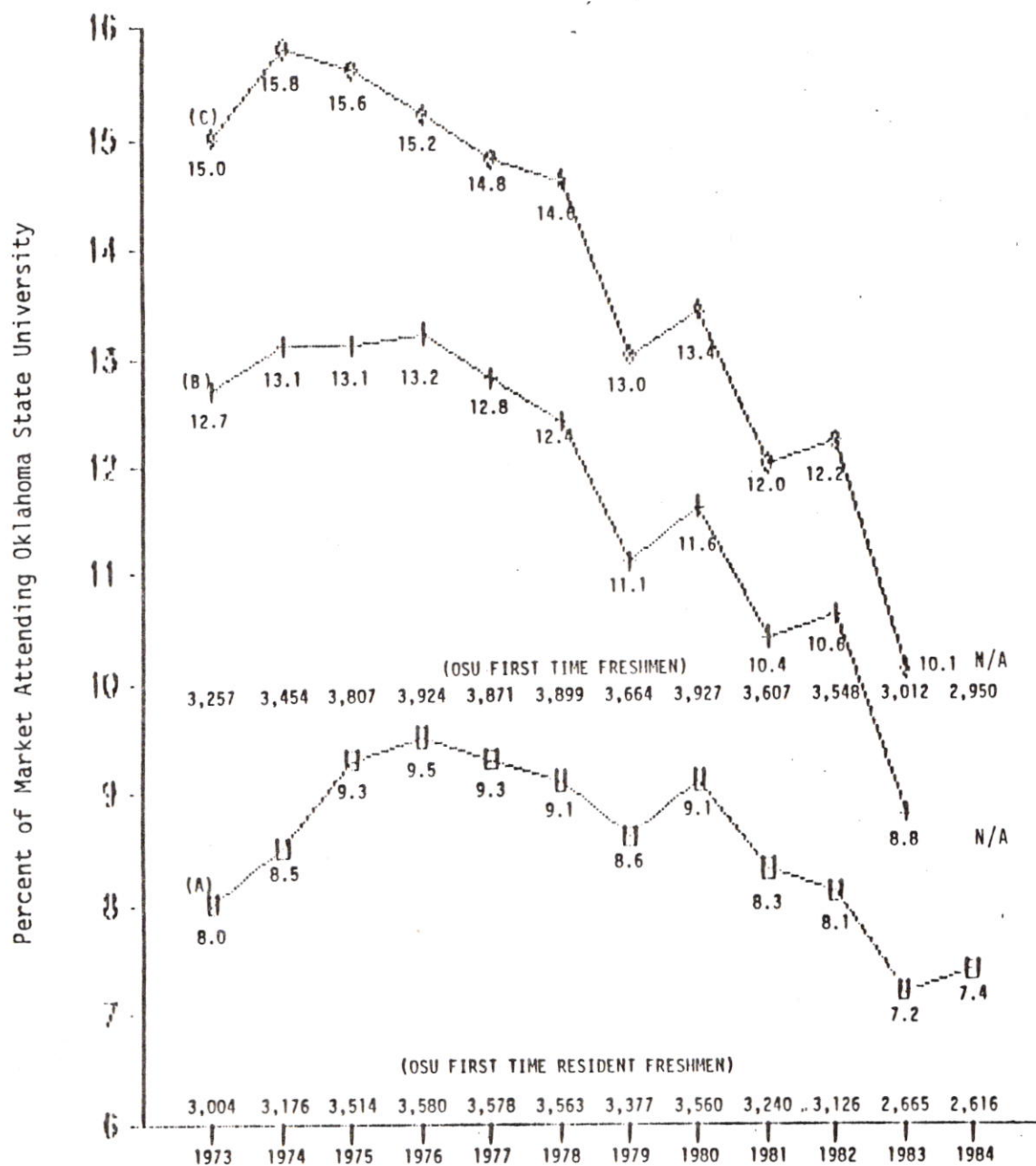
A retention study is done each fall illustrating the flow of students from class to class with respect to the previous fall semester to the present fall semester. Upon reviewing these studies one finds the retention of a specific class varies little from year to year, but the distribution of the students to different classes varies more. The table on page 80 illustrates this point.

One can develop models which project the overall retention better than a particular group advancing to the next class. This method decreases the amount of error when projecting total headcount.

Graduate enrollment is not easy to project with respect to the same variables as undergraduate enrollment. The Higher Education Budget for Oklahoma had a more than usual effect on Fall 1984 enrollment. The amount of available funding for graduate students from departments and the emphasis of the departments on recruiting graduate students are major factors which are affecting enrollment, and must be taken into consideration when making projections. Input by Oklahoma State University's Dean of the Graduate College on policy and future funding is reflected in the graduate enrollment projections. At the present time, his belief is that graduate enrollment will be down for the next few years if present administrative practices are followed with respect to graduate student employment.

The enrollment projections were not extended to more than three years due to the many factors affecting college enrollment in Oklahoma at the present time. OSU will be putting more emphasis on marketing with regard to both high school and junior college students. Also, retention of students at OSU will be receiving more attention in the future. Therefore, when enrollment models have been developed using historical data, changes in policy are not reflected in those models until after being in existence for a few years. New enrollment models involving more emphasis on delphi techniques will be developed in the future.

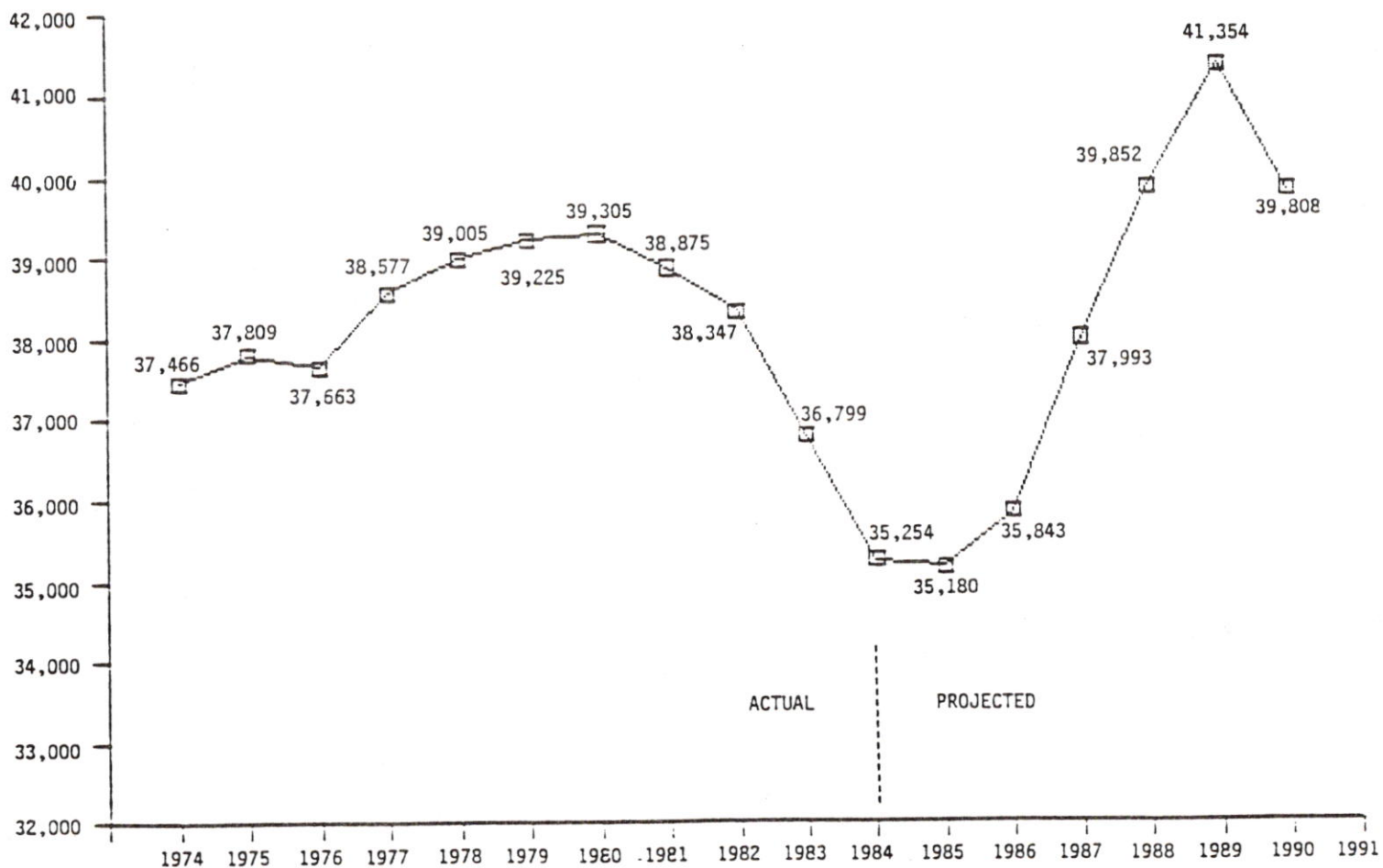

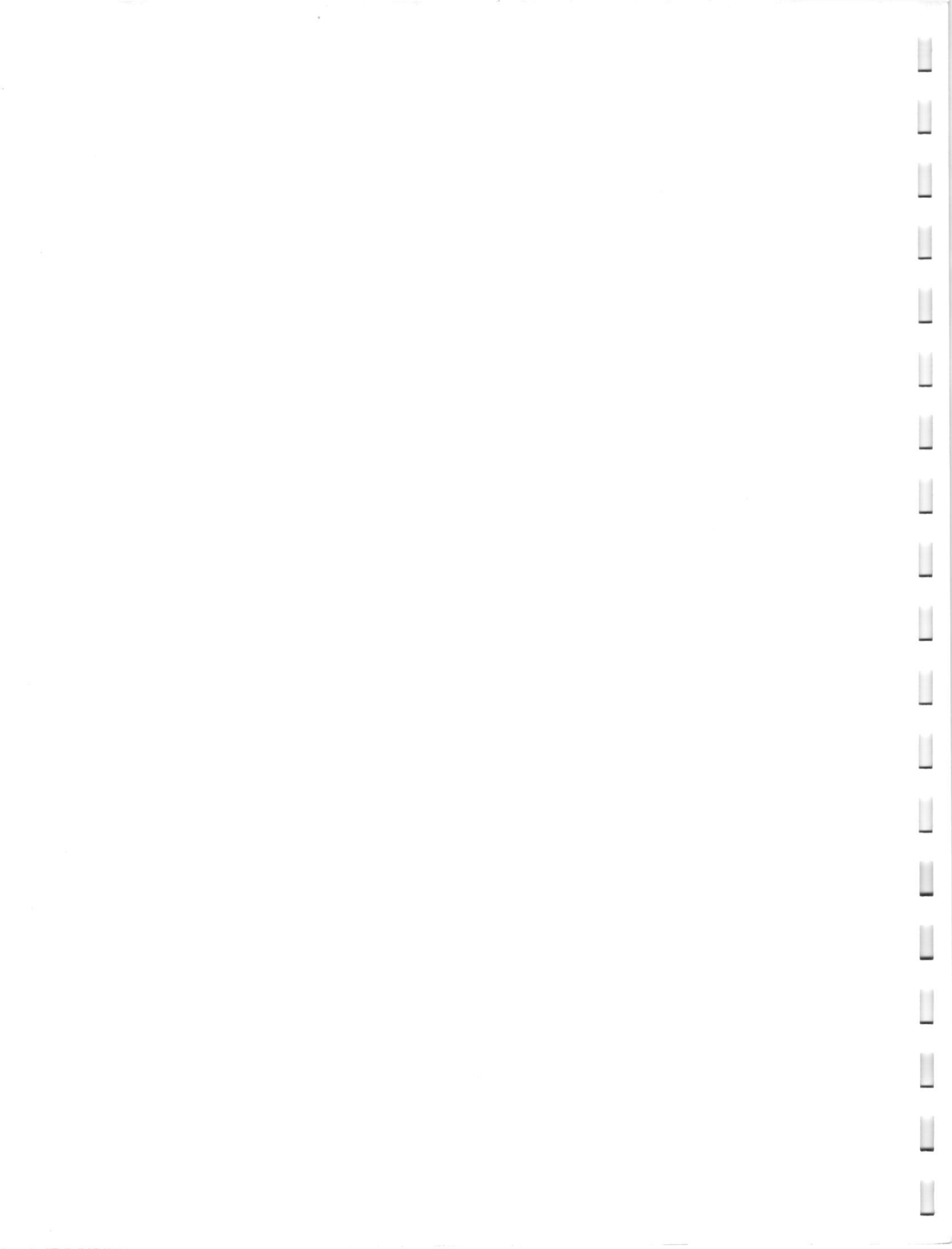

## GLOSSARY

### Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 84. Therefore, students born in January 1965 and December 1965 will both be reported as age 19 (84-65).

### Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshmen, sophomores, juniors, seniors, special undergraduates, special graduates, masters, and doctorates.

### College

The university is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agriculture (AG); Arts and Sciences (AS); Business Administration (BU); Education (ED); Engineering, Technology and Architecture (CEAT); and Home Economics (HE). Data for Engineering, Technology and Architecture are sometimes divided into two data sets--one for the School of Technology (Tech Inst or School of Tech), and the second for Engineering and Architecture (EN).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, there are the Graduate College and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

### Educational TV Students

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa. A student who is enrolled in courses at OSU and who is also enrolled in an Educational TV course is counted as an OSU student (see Student Location).

### Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU excluding non-resident aliens (Non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

- White: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe (except Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia and Iran.
- Black: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Africa south of the Sahara.
- Native American: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America.
- Hispanic: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Spain and Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spainards, and Portuguese.
- Asian: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Phillippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian sub-continent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (including non-residnet aliens), some tables and figures

which present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the non-resident alien population.

#### Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a non-resident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission the student is categorized as a non-resident alien.

#### Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

#### Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is one who has not yet selected a major. A special graduate student is a student with a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university who is admitted to the graduate college and is taking courses at OSU, but who does not have immediate plans to become a degree candidate.

### Student Location

Beginning with Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File is defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

- 0 Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
- 1 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking OSU courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCT)
- 2 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCT)
- 3 Enrolled in OSU courses only through the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back Television system (EDTV or ETV or Educational TV students)
- 4 Enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV and also at the University Center at Tulsa (ETV + UCT)
- 5 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV (OSU + ETV)
- 6 Enrolled in OSU courses on the main campus, through Educational TV and at University Center at Tulsa (OSU + ETV + UCT)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5 and 6 above).

### Type of Admission

New students admitted to OSU are classified as a new freshman, a transfer



student or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshman are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).
