We encourage users of this publication to direct their comments, questions and suggestions about its contents to the Office of Institutional Research.

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















RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY




NON-RESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE




RESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY COUNTY


VETERINARY MEDICINE ENROLLMENT BY CLASSIFICATION, RACE AND SEX FALL SEMESTER 1986













PERCENT ENROLLMENT BY HEADCOUNT





PERCENT ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME EQUIVALENCY









These students are shown as "% Non-Returning." 34.0% of the black students enrolled in the Fall Semester 1985 had gone on to graduate prior to the Fall Semester 1986.

Return rate is computed by comparing the previous fall semester class to the current fall semester class by matching on student identification number. If a student's identification number matches, he/she is a continuing student. An example is: Of the 5,553 freshmen for Fall 1980, 3,837 returned the following fall semester giving a return rate of 69.1.

OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

The new freshmen enrollment for the current year at Oklahoma State
University is composed of 88.9% Oklahoma residents, and 11.1% non Oklahoma
residents. This has changed little over the past ten years. Therefore, the
principal basis for student enrollment projections must be the youth population
of Oklahoma. One can easily understand that the Oklahoma high schools are the
major source of OSU students. Therefore, the enrollment projections of OSU
students must be based on a projection of Oklahoma high school graduates. The
changes in the Oklahoma economy appear to have had an effect on out migration
of the Oklahoma population which also affects high school enrollments. In
1983, it appeared that the 1989 high school graduating class would be the
largest ever to exist in Oklahoma. It now appears that it will be larger than
those for the past few years but not any larger than it was for 1979 or 1980.
Thus, some of the optimism for larger than ever enrollments in the 1990's will
not materialize, but an increase over present enrollment levels will develop
starting about 1989.


Previously, the Oklahoma State Department of Public Education published a report illustrating the flow of students in public school systems of Oklahoma. This document was the source used as a basis for projecting Oklahoma public high school graduates in order to project the new freshman class at Oklahoma State University. The Oklahoma Statistical Data Center does not publish the same report now but does publish a similar report, which can be used for projection purposes. A retention study is done each fall illustrating the flow of students from class to class with respect to the previous fall semester to the present fall semester. Upon reviewing these studies, one finds the retention of a specific class varies some from year to year, but the distribution of the students to different classes varies more.

The table on page 80 illustrates this point. Models which project overall retention can be developed better than models which project a particular group advancing to the next class. This method decreases the amount of error when projecting total headcount.

Graduate enrollment is not easy to project with respect to the same variables as undergraduate enrollment. The amount of available funding for graduate students from departments and the emphasis of the departments on recruiting graduate students are major factors which affect enrollment and must be taken into consideration when making projections. Policy and future funding input supplied by the Dean of the Graduate College at Oklahoma State University is reflected in the graduate enrollment projections. At the present time, his belief is that graduate enrollment will increase a small amount for the next few years if present administrative practices are followed with respect to graduate student employment.

OSU will be putting more emphasis on marketing with regard to both high school and junior college students. Also, retention of students at OSU will be receiving more attention in the future. The model will require modification due to the added emphasis in both marketing and retention for the next few years. Also changes in policy are not reflected in those models until after being in existence for a few years. New enrollment models involving more emphasis on delphi techniques will be developed in the future.



GLOSSARY

Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 86. Therefore, students born in January 1966 and December 1966 will both be reported as age 20 (86-66).

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agriculture (AG);
Arts and Sciences (AS); Business Administration (BU); Education (ED);
Engineering, Technology and Architecture (CEAT); and Home Economics (HE). Data for Engineering, Technology and Architecture are sometimes divided into two data sets—one for the School of Technology (TI), and the second for Engineering and Architecture (EN).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, there are the Graduate College and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Educational TV Students

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa. A student who is enrolled in courses at OSU and who is also enrolled in an Educational TV course is counted as an OSU student (see Student Location).

Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU excluding non-resident aliens (Non-U.S. citizens) is divided into the following categories:

White: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Europe (except Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria, Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia and Iran.

Black: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Africa south of the Sahara.

Native American: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of North and South America.

Hispanic: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Spain and Portugal. This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans, Puerto Ricans, Spainards, and Portuguese.

Asian: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Phillipines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian sub-continent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (<u>including</u> non-resident aliens), some tables and figures which

present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the non-resident alien population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a non-resident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as a non-resident alien.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a nondegree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a nondegree seeking student admitted to the graduate college.

Student Location

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File is defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

- O Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
- 1 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCT)
- 2 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCT)
- 3 Enrolled in OSU courses only through the Oklahoma State Regents for
 Higher Education's Talk-Back Television system (EDTV or ETV or
 Educational TV students)
 - 4 Enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV and also at the
 University Center at Tulsa (ETV + UCT)
 - 5 Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV (OSU + ETV)
 - 6 Enrolled in OSU courses on the main campus, through Educational TV and at University Center at Tulsa (OSU + ETV + UCT)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5 and 6 above).

Type of Admission

New students admitted to OSU are classified as a new freshman, a transfer student or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).

Prior to Fall 1986, students admitted as adult specials are classified as transfer students. Beginning in Fall 1986, these students are classified as new freshmen students.
