

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OSU STUDENT PROFILE: AT-A-GLANCE

GENERAL DATA AND TRENDS

- Undergraduate students represent every county in Oklahoma and 47 states.
- Counting all students (undergraduate and graduate), all 77 counties in Oklahoma, all 50 states, and 100 foreign countries are represented within OSU's student body.
- In 1994, new freshmen are enrolled on the OSU-Kyoto campus for the first time.
- The percentage of new freshmen coming from high school classes of fewer than 50 rose from 14.5% in 1993 to 17.5% in 1994. Students coming from classes larger than 900 went up from 0.4% to 2.1%.
- In 1994, Oklahoma State University suffered its 12th straight decrease in main campus enrollment. The number of students topped the 23,000 mark in 1982, but since has fallen to 17,784.
- Although enrollment decreased, OSU's percent share of Oklahoma high school Spring 1994 graduates increased slightly to 5.9%. This compares with 6.5% in 1989 and 7.4% in 1984.
- OSU's percent share of the total enrollment in Oklahoma's public higher education system remained at 11.1%.

STUDENT BODY DATA AND TRENDS

Source of Students

- Total resident new freshmen increased from 1,841 in 1993 to 1,877 in 1994. These students may be coming less from metro areas and more from rural areas, as Oklahoma and Tulsa Counties combined for a 68-student drop.
- Two hundred sixty-eight fewer resident undergraduates consider Oklahoma or Tulsa Counties home.
- Nonresident undergraduates increased during the past year--from 1,953 in 1993 to 2,180 in 1994.
 Playing the primary role in this increase were nonresident alien students with a 21.9% increase.
- Of the 100 foreign countries represented at OSU, the top ten (making up 75.8% of the nonresident alien student body) are in the area located from the Indian peninsula to the Far East.
- Excluding nonresident aliens, out-of-state enrollment continues to increase--from 7.1% in 1984 to 9.4% in 1994.
- For six of the past ten years, OSU's top feeder high school has been Stillwater High School. Of the remaining four years, Edmond Memorial boasts the most Cowboys.

Composition of Student Body

- Both resident minority students and nonresident minority students increased from 1993 to 1994.
- The percentage of white students has fallen for six straight years, dipping to 78.1% of the student body this fall.
- Total Native American enrollment on the main campus has almost doubled in the past five years, from 613 in 1989 to 1,044 in 1994.
- During the past 10 years, Native American enrollment has increased 151%, Hispanic 87.2%, and Asian 47.3%; however, Black enrollment has decreased 26.2%.
- In 1989, nonresident aliens made up 7.3% of OSU's student body; in 1994, that percentage increased to 10.1%.
- Over the last ten years, female enrollment has dropped 8.5%. Male enrollment, however, has plummeted 19.7%.
- OSU's lowest percentage of female enrollment occurred last year (45.3%); the highest was in 1990, at 45.9%. This fall, females constitute 45.5% of the student body.
- The average age of undergraduate students has increased steadily from 21.9 in 1989 to 22.4 in 1994.
 The percentage of undergraduate females under the age of 22 decreased from 79% in 1989 to 75% in 1994; of undergraduate males, 72% in 1989 to 65% in 1994.
- Graduate student age has remained fairly constant--32.7 in 1989 to 32.4 in 1994. The percentage of graduate females under the age of 26 increased from 24% in 1989 to 29% in 1994; of graduate males, 27% in 1989 to 31% in 1994.
- Graduate population increased from 20.6% in 1989 to 22.7% in 1992, and then decreased the following two years (to 21.6% in 1994). Fewer special graduate students account for the decrease.

COLLEGE DATA AND TRENDS

- Two colleges witnessed enrollment increases from Fall 1993 to Fall 1994: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources and University Academic Services.
- Two colleges have seen their percentage share of undergraduate enrollment decrease over the past five years. The percentage of students enrolled in the College of Business Administration fell from 24.3% in 1989 to 18.3% in 1994, and the percentage of students in University Academic Services decreased from 7.1% to 6.0%.
- Only two colleges saw an increase in their actual number of undergraduate majors over the past five years: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources and Engineering, Architecture, and Technology.

ACADEMIC DATA AND TRENDS

- The average ACT composite for all new freshmen has steadily increased from 23.02 in 1990 to 23.67 in 1994.
- After remaining at 23.9 for three years, the composite ACT average of new freshmen males increased to 24.1 in 1994, the highest average ever. The composite ACT average of new freshmen females also continued to increase to a new high average of 23.4.
- The average ACT composite for Asian new freshmen fell from 24.3 in 1993 to 21.8 in 1994. All other races remained relatively constant.
- New freshmen earned a 3.42 high school grade point average in 1994, compared to 3.26 in 1989 and 3.09 in 1984.
- The percentage of new freshmen students reporting a 3.60 or higher high school grade point average surpassed 50 percent for the first time. In 1989, the percentage of students earning such a GPA was 37.4; and in 1984 the percentage was only 23.5.
- Nonresident alien undergraduate students' overall OSU grade point average decreased from 2.95 in 1993 to 2.90 in 1994. All other categories of students maintained or increased their average.
- When calculated by college/division, the only overall undergraduate GPA decrease occurred within the Division of Technology, which fell from 2.64 to 2.58. At the graduate level, overall GPA decreased within Human Environmental Sciences (from 3.57 to 3.53) and in Veterinary Medicine (from 3.03 to 3.00).

RETENTION DATA AND TRENDS

- Retention of new freshmen has remained relatively stable, as have graduation rates of new freshmen.
- First-year retention rates for new transfer students (72.3%) have increased over the past three years, becoming more comparable with first-year retention rates for new freshmen (76.2%).
- Second-, third-, and fourth-year graduation rates for new transfers have decreased in recent years, suggesting that transfer students as a group are taking longer to graduate.
- In 1984, the ratio of new transfers to new freshmen was 73%; in 1994, the ratio was 87%. The
 increasing proportion of new transfers, coupled with their increasing retention rates and the increasing
 length of time they need to graduate, combine to mean that transfer students are in every way
 becoming a more significant source of undergraduate students for OSU.















NONRESIDENT UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE





NONRESIDENT GRADUATE STUDENTS BY STATE
















ENROLLMENT CHANGE OVER THE PAST TWELVE YEARS (1983-1994) (Expressed in Percentages)
















AVERAGE CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE OF UNIVERSITY ACADEMIC SERVICES STUDENTS










These students are shown as "% Non-Returning;" 42.4% of the Native American senior students enrolled in the fall semester 1991 had gone on to graduate prior to the fall semester 1992.



OSU FALL SEMESTER HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT PROJECTIONS

The start of a new administration at Oklahoma State University has brought a renewed emphasis on student enrollments. As a result some new initiatives have been and will be put into place to attract new students. The projections in this section are mathematical models based on past performance and do not reflect any of these new initiatives. Sources for new students on campus are new freshmen, new graduate students, transfer students, and readmitted students. In the past, the new student category has been the best source for increased enrollment. This fall, OSU had 2,177 new freshmen, 750 new graduate students, 1,428 undergraduate transfers, and 616 readmitted undergraduate students. OSU's goals for Fall 1995 include adding 200 more new freshmen, 200 more new undergraduate transfers, and restoring the number of new graduate students to the fall 1993 level.


The new freshman enrollment for Fall 1994 is composed of 86.5% Oklahoma residents and 13.5% non-Oklahoma residents (including international students). Historically, the percentage of new freshmen who are Oklahoma residents has been above 85% with year-to-year fluctuations of less than 1%. The number of resident new freshmen rose for the first time in six years. This parallels the rise in the number of high school graduates within the state. Consequently, forecasts of the number of Oklahoma high school graduates are still the most important factor for projecting OSU new freshmen enrollment.

The forecast of Oklahoma high school graduates used in this section is based upon information received from the Oklahoma State Department of Education. It assumes that demographic trends such as immigration into and emigration out of the state will remain relatively constant.

In summary, several factors complicate enrollment projections at OSU. Some of these factors depend on policy decisions originating with the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and some depend on recruitment policies set by OSU administration. The impact of any new initiatives as well as changing admissions, retention, scholarship, and recruiting policies will require the passage of some time in order for their effect to be reflected in the data used as a basis for enrollment projections. As the impact of these policies becomes clear, a new enrollment forecasting model will be developed.





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GLOSSARY

Age

A student's age is computed by subtracting year of birth from 1994. Therefore, students born in January 1972 and December 1972 will both be reported as age 22 (1994-1972).

Classification

Classification describes the student level and/or type and includes freshman, sophomore, junior, senior, special undergraduate, special graduate, master, and doctorate.

College

The University is divided into six undergraduate colleges: Agricultural Sciences & Natural Resources (ASNR); Arts and Sciences (AS); Business Administration (CBA); Education (ED); Engineering, Architecture, and Technology (CEAT); and Human Environmental Sciences (HES). Data for CEAT are sometimes divided into two data sets--one for Engineering & Architecture (EN), and the second for the Division of Technology (TECH).

In addition to these six undergraduate colleges, students may enroll in the University Academic Services, the Graduate College, and the College of Veterinary Medicine. In this report, students enrolled in the Graduate College are usually distributed for reporting purposes to the respective undergraduate college which administers their major coursework.

Educational TV Students

An Educational TV student is a student who is taking OSU coursework via the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back television system. The student may or may not also be enrolled in courses at the University Center at Tulsa. A student who is enrolled in courses at OSU and who is also enrolled in an Educational TV course is counted as an OSU student (see Student Location).

Race Codes and Definitions

For purposes of reporting OSU enrollment by race, the total enrollment at OSU <u>excluding</u> <u>non-resident aliens (non-U.S. citizens)</u> is divided into the following categories:

White: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe (except

Spain and Portugal), North Africa (above the Sahara), or the Middle East. This category would include, for instance: Italy, France, the British Isles, Scandinavia, Germany, Russia, Romania, Greece, Turkey, Morocco, Algeria,

Libya, Egypt, Iraq, Israel, Saudi Arabia, and Iran.

Black: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Africa south of the

Sahara.

Native American: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of North or South

America.

Hispanic: All persons having <u>origins</u> in any of the <u>original</u> peoples of Spain or Portugal.

This category would generally include, for instance: Chicanos, Mexican-Americans, Mexicans, Central and South Americans, Cubans,

Puerto Ricans, Spaniards, and Portuguese.

Asian: All persons having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East,

Southeast Asia, or the Pacific Islands. This category would include, for instance: China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, Vietnam, the Philippines, Samoa, Indonesia, New Zealand, Australia, and the Indian subcontinent which includes all persons from Afghanistan, Nepal, Burma, India, and Pakistan.

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In order to present a set of data regarding OSU enrollment which sums to OSU's total enrollment (including nonresident aliens), some tables and figures which present data by race in this report include an additional column or row of data pertaining to the balance of the student body--the nonresident alien population.

Resident Status

A student is categorized as a resident if he or she was a legal resident of the State of Oklahoma at the time of original admission to OSU. If not a legal resident of Oklahoma at the time of admission, the student is a nonresident. If the student was a legal resident of a country other than the United States at the time of admission, the student is categorized as a nonresident alien.

Retention

Student retention is usually expressed as a percentage figure which is derived by comparing the size of a specific group of students who were enrolled at OSU for a given semester to the size of the same group when they are enrolled for a successive given semester.

A non-returning student is defined as a student who was enrolled at OSU for a given semester and who did not graduate and who did not return to OSU for a successive given semester.

Special Undergraduate/Graduate Student

A special undergraduate student is a non-degree seeking student who has not earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. A special graduate student is a non-degree seeking student admitted to the Graduate College.

Student Location

Beginning with the Fall Semester 1983, every student on the Student Master File was defined by one of the following Student Location Codes:

0	Enrolled only in courses on the OSU main campus (OSU)
1	Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also taking courses at the University Center at Tulsa (OSU + UCT)
2	Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the University Center at Tulsa (UCT)
3	Enrolled in OSU courses only through the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education's Talk-Back Television system (ETV or Educational TV students)
4	Enrolled in OSU courses through Educational TV and also at the University Center at Tulsa (ETV + UCT)
5	Enrolled in courses on the OSU main campus and also enrolled in OSU

courses through Educational TV (OSU + ETV)

- Enrolled in OSU courses on the main campus, through Educational TV and at University Center at Tulsa (OSU + ETV + UCT)
 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at University Center at Enid. (UCE)
- 8 Enrolled in OSU courses only offered at the branch campus located in Kyoto, Japan (OSU-Kyoto)

For purposes of reporting data, students are reported as UCT students only if they are enrolled in OSU courses exclusively at the University Center at Tulsa (2 above). Students are reported as Educational TV students if they are enrolled in an Educational TV course but are NOT also enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus (3 and 4 above). If a student is enrolled in a course on the OSU main campus, he or she is reported as a "main campus" student, irrespective of whether that student is also enrolled in an Educational TV course(s) offered at the University Center at Tulsa (0, 1, 5, and 6 above).

Type of Admission

A new student admitted to OSU is classified as a new freshman, a transfer student, or a readmission. All other students are classified as returning students. A transfer student is classified as such only for the first semester that he attends OSU; after one semester a transfer student is reclassified as a returning student. Similarly, new freshmen are reclassified as returning students after their first semester at OSU (and are sometimes shown as "other freshmen" when presenting data by classification). A readmission student is a student who has enrolled at OSU in the past but who has not been enrolled at OSU during the previous semester (excluding the summer semester).

Prior to Fall 1986, students admitted as adult specials were classified as transfer students. Beginning in Fall 1986, these students were classified as new freshmen students.
